Preschoolers' Storytime



Thursdays at 10:00 a.m.

Designed for children from 3 to 6 years of age, Preschoolers' Storytime is an early literacy program that uses interactive stories, songs, and activities to help your preschooler get ready to read. Your child will build language, math, listening and social skills, while having fun! Craft included. (Coloring sheets for 2 y/o & younger.)

April 6 – “The Very Busy Tree”– In honor of National Arbor Day, we will take a look at things trees add to our world (like backyard treehouses, paper for books, and homes for animals.) Trees are for hugging!

April 13 – “Eggstraordinary Easter Tales” – Fun stories of the E.B.'s Easter adventures as he hops down the Bunny Trail. (With our own special version of an “egg” hunt!)

April 20 – “Six Ways to Tell if You’re a Frog” – Whether you are—or are not—a frog, National Frog Month is the perfect time to enjoy books about our favorite amphibians. Frogs are awesome, warts and all!

April 27 – “Tell a Story Day” – Stories today will be shared in the oral tradition (through speech and song.) All children and parents are invited to tell a story, too!

Of course, older children are always welcome.**
