JOB DESCRIPTION

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR II

CODE: 410

DESCRIPTION

This is work in the operation of a limited variety of types of heavy equipment used in street and sanitation work.

Employees in this class are usually responsible for the safe and efficient operation of only a few pieces of heavy equipment and only as applied to moderately complex construction, maintenance and sanitation activities. Employees receive specific and in some cases detailed instructions from a supervisor as to maintenance or construction assignments involving equipment operations. Work is performed according to established procedures with frequent inspections during progress and final inspection of work completed.

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED

(All duties listed may not be found in each position, nor does the list include all tasks, which may be assigned to positions in this class.)

Operate a heavy type tractor-trailer in hauling heavy machine and construction equipment.

Operate a motor grader in digging ditches, grading shoulders, shaping back slopes, shaping driveways, mixing base course, spreading gravel, and other rough grading.

Operate a bulldozer in clearing, grubbing, backfilling, and performing grading or moving work.

Operate a backhoe, trencher, side broom or forklift in installing and repairing utility lines.

Drive tractor drawing large mower.

Operate either front or rear end of a distributor, asphalt spreader or roller, tank car heater, and a variety of loaders.

Operate truck with front-end loader; pick up garbage containers and haul to City dump; load rock, gravel, sand; stump on trucks; dig trenches; fill holes with gravel.

Ability to withstand long work hours under adverse weather conditions.

Conduct servicing or light maintenance work on equipment operated.

Perform related work as assigned.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Considerable knowledge of the general practices applied in the care and safe operation of heavy construction, maintenance, and sanitation equipment.

Considerable knowledge of the practices applied in the use of heavy equipment for various maintenance, construction and sanitation equipment.

Skill in the operation of the equipment assigned.

Ability to make emergency repairs and running adjustments.

Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions, operating procedures and roles.

Ability to withstand long work hours operating heavy equipment over rough terrain and occasionally under adverse weather conditions.

Ability to operate assigned equipment in emergencies under adverse weather conditions after normal working hours, as necessary.

QUALIFICATIONS

Completion of the eighth school grade.

Considerable experience in the operation of the equipment to which assigned in street and road construction and maintenance work or sanitation work.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Must possess a valid State of Alabama driver's license, a valid State of Alabama commercial driver's (CDL -Class B) license, and must obtain a valid CDL-Class A within six months of hiring, and a driving record suitable for insurability.
