QUALIFICATIONS

- Formal instruction in fire fighting methods and techniques; extensive experience in firefighting and emergency medical service work including some experience in a supervisory capacity.
- Diploma from an accredited high school or equivalent.
- A valid Alabama driver's license as well as a driving record suitable for insurability.
- Maintain a presentable degree of fitness and have sufficient speech, hearing or other communication capabilities, with or without reasonable accommodation.
- Must pass the City's required drug tests prior to employment.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- Supplemental training program coursework in fire administration, planning and methods desirable (such as National Fire Academy's Executive Fire Officer Program, Alabama Fire College Personnel Standards and Training Commission Fire Officer certification) or other training.
- Must have met the minimum standards as established by the Alabama Firefighters Personnel Standards and Training Commission for Firefighter I, Firefighter II, Fire Officer I, Fire Instructor I, and Fire Investigator I.
- Must obtain within 2 years of hire date the certifications for Fire Officer II, Fire Instructor II or forfeit employment.
- Fifteen years of full-time experience as a firefighter or officer with progressively increased assumption of responsibility and performance.
