1. Present are Jack Plunk, Chief Thompson, Ron Wilson, Mr. Wirtz, LynnWirtz, and Suzy Spiceland Michelson, Mr. Edmiston. Guest: Mr. Langley
2. #5 should say still need shirts on display at the rec center. Motion to accept the minutes: Chief. Second by Jack. Passed.
3. Resignations by Mr. Poe and Mr. Campeaux have been accepted by the Council. We have names to give for replacements. Hopefully, they will be accepted soon. Mr. Harvey and Mr. Langley are two names. We may need a third. The mayor may have a person in mind.
4. We now have a good enough map to use. Jack will try to get handouts replaced at the depot with our new map and talk about replacing the existing maps at the trail. He will get together with Janis Burns about this.
5. We still have \$420. We've sold no more shirts. We still need to see about getting those shirts on display at the rec center. Jack will check with Ms. Burns about a display when he discusses #4 with her. Mr. Wilson mentioned getting a display cabinet made to hang the shirts near the door. Jack suggested using rubber stoppers in the window.
6. Phase 2 has not started on the sharrows. We are hoping these will be done by this summer. Stanley Carr will need to see about getting that to happen. Jack will email him to see if he can make this happen.
7. Jack discussed how we have been making the 5 E's a reality, hitting each one and naming the evidence of progress. Sharrows and repaving are two components. Also, our brochures, "share the road" signs, and bike racks help. We need to expand on these. Handing out our maps at the local hotels would be good. Maybe we can get an article in the paper about the sharrows and our new maps.
