ORDER

The public safety and health interest concerns at this time regarding the community spread of the Coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) and the Court's response to mitigate the community spread to our citizens, employees and those required to be present in Court on May 5th and May 12th, 2020 shall be reset by separate orders. Inmate cases will be monitored and handled as necessary. This is in compliance with the Alabama Supreme Court Order dated April 30th, 2020, that all in person hearings and trials are suspended in municipal courts until May 15th, 2020. When the Jacksonville Municipal Court resumes court dates, all attorneys, parties, witnesses, and persons in the Courtroom will be required to wear a mask, no exceptions. Once court dates resume, no one will be allowed in the Courtroom except for parties, witnesses and attorneys. Furthermore, once court dates resume, parties and witnesses will not be allowed to bring minor children or other persons into the Courtroom.
