

# Recycling Collection Service

Republic Services provides curbside recycling, with one scheduled pick-up per every other week. Each household is provided a recycling cart, and your participation is optional. The cart should be placed curbside the night before your collection day, and removed by 7:00 p.m. the day of collection.



## Recycling Information

Recycling is picked up every other week on Wednesday. Large cardboard boxes are removed as "Trash" by the City Street Department on your assigned trash pickup day.

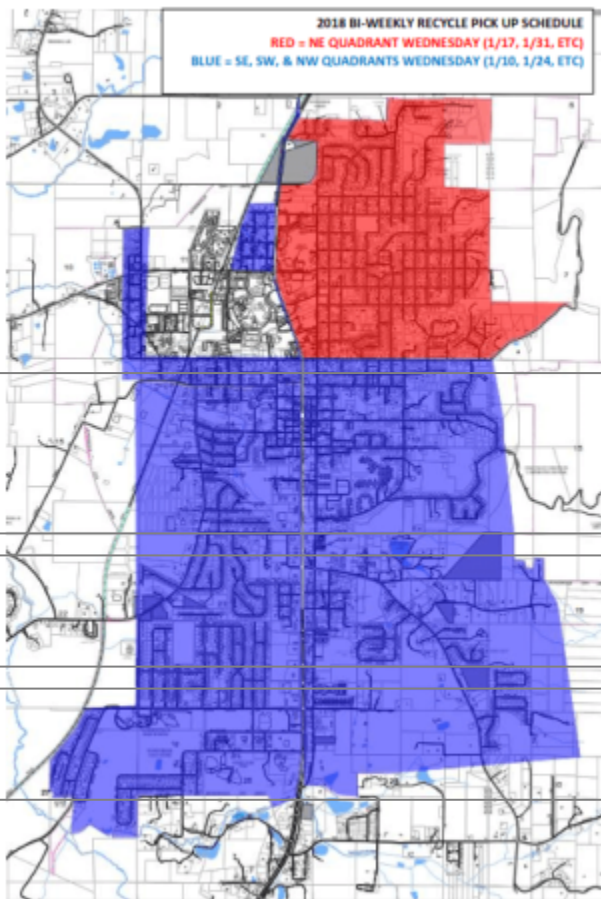
## Items collected: Click [Approved Items Recycle Flyer](#) link below.

- Cans – aluminum, steel and tin (please rinse the cans).
- Aluminum – foil or baking tins.
- Paper – newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper and phone books.
- Plastic – bottles that have a 1 on the bottom such as soft drink bottles, water bottles, mouthwash bottles, and plastic jars.
- Plastic - bottles that have a 2 on the bottom such as laundry detergent, milk jugs, shampoo bottles, and cleaning supply bottles.
- Cardboard – corrugated boxes, small packing boxes (please break down).
