

**City Council Meeting Minutes
June 12, 2017
Jacksonville, Alabama**

The City Council of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, met for the regular Council Meeting on Monday, June 12, 2017, at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Court Room at the Public Safety Complex, 911 Public Safety Drive, Jacksonville, Alabama. Council President Sandra Fox Sudduth called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. Upon roll call, the following Council Members were present: Jimmy L. Harrell, Jr., Tony Taylor and Coty Galloway. Council Member Jerry Parris was absent. Financial Control Officer (FCO)/City Administrator, City Clerk and City Attorney were present. Mayor was absent.


COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS. Council Member Taylor stated the Council appreciates all the Citizens speaking at the meeting.
