

**City Council Meeting Minutes**  
**July 9, 2018**  
**Jacksonville, Alabama**

The City Council of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, met for the Regular Council Meeting on Monday, July 9, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Court Room at the Public Safety Complex, 911 Public Safety Drive, Jacksonville, Alabama. Council President Sandra Fox Sudduth called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Upon roll call, the following Council Members were present: Jerry Parris, Jimmy L. Harrell Jr., Tony Taylor, and Coty Galloway. Mayor, City Clerk and City Attorney were present.

A motion was made by Council Member Galloway, seconded by Council Member Harrell, to approve the June 25, 2018 Work Session and Council Meeting Minutes. Upon vote on the motion, the following votes were recorded: Yeas: All; Nays: None. The Council President announced the motion carried.

The Council President asked for corrections or additions to the Agenda.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS.** The Council President asked for comments. There were none.

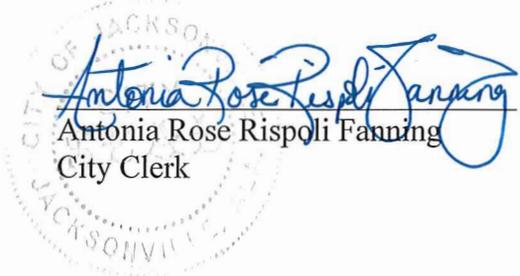

**MAYOR'S REPORT.**

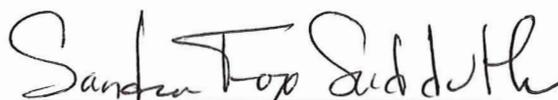
- Thanks Parks & Recreation Department, Janis and all those who made JaxFest wonderful.
