Comments on Sharrows: Both Phase I and Phase II are complete, but fading. Phase III has not been confirmed as complete

George Douthit sidewalk: Per Chief Thompson, the trees near the Public Service Bldg are being removed due to disease which opens the area for future installation of a sidewalk on the South side of the road. No information as to the start and/or completion date.

Bike Racks: Per Scott Edmiston, he is talking with Jack's, Dollar General is a hold out and the Chief stated there were 2 bike racks at the new Public Service Building.

Signage on CLT: Per Scott, the Chair will inquire as to the repair of the signage via the Path Foundation which is responsible for amenities on the Silver Comet Trail and/or Pete Conroy of Jacksonville State University. (Signs on CLT connection with Silver Comet in Georgia are missing letters)
