Preschoolers' Storytime

Thursdays at 10:00 a.m.

Designed for children from 3 to 6 years of age, Preschoolers' Storytime is an early literacy program that uses interactive stories, songs, and activities to help your preschooler get ready to read. Your child will build language, math, listening and social skills, while having fun! Craft included. (Coloring sheets for 2 y/o & younger.)

Feb. 7 – "Z is for Zoo" – Why do animals live in the zoo? What kind of animals live there? Who takes care of them? Let's find out what's new at the zoo!

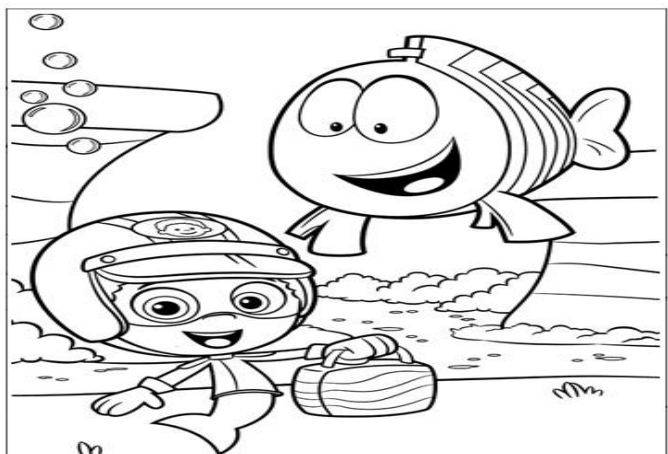
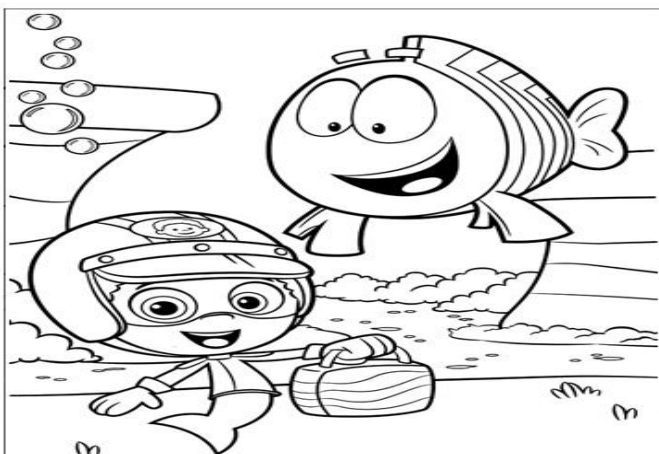
