Minutes - May 10, 2016

Present: Jack Plunk, Lynn Hoffman-Wirtz, Scott Edmiston, Ron Wilson

Jack called the meeting to order at 6:05pm and asked for a review of the JBAC minutes from March 15. Jack mentioned that Ms. Susy Michelson, JBAC Secretary has recently died in a car accident and he and Lynn had constructed these minutes from their memory and notes. A few additions were made to complete names of City staff mentioned in the minutes. The minutes were adopted on and motion from Lynn and a second of that motion by Scott. The minutes were adopted with additions.

Next Ron filed the Treasurers report. Ron reported that a couple of t-shirts had sold but we have a remaining balance of \$1,880 after our \$50 LAB fee and the \$500 donation to support the Cruise. Ron provided an inventory of the t-shirts remaining.

Jack then asked for the Committees thoughts on the proposed donation to the City to assist in the sink hole repair work necessary on the Chief. After a short discussion, Ron suggested that the proposal be tabled until the July meeting. The JBAC agreed that this decision would be tabled until the JBAC meeting scheduled for July 19th.

Jack then mentioned Sharrows Phase 3 and asked if anyone had seen new Sharrows on Greenleaf St., 2nd Ave., G. Douthit or any of the other Phase 3 road segments. No one had seen any new Sharrows for Phase 3 but everyone has seen that Phase 1 and Phase 2 Sharrows had recently been repainted and were easy to see. So the City has responded and most of the earliest Sharrows have been repainted.

Jack mentioned the table at the May 15th Cruise/Challenge registration and Ms. Booke Nelson the Ride Director said we could set up the table on Sat. night or Sunday morning about 5pm, since there would be overnight security. After some discussion, it was decided that Jack would drop off the freebees and SWAG on Sat. night and Ron would bring T-shirts early Sunday morning.

Ron also mentioned talking to Mayor Baker of Piedmont and reported that the bridge rehab project had been completed. Lynn and Ron mentioned that all but one had a concrete decking and the Nances Creek bridge had been re-decked with lumber.

Ron also suggested that some addition benches be installed at a few of the bridges and overlooks near some of the water features on the Chief.

The next JBAC meeting is scheduled for July 19th. There being no other business the JBAC adjourned at 6:35pm.
