

Jacksonville Bicycle Advisory Committee (JBAC) Meeting 5/20/14 5:51 PM
Jacksonville Recreation Center

1. Present are Lynn Hoffman-Wirtz, Mike Langley, Ron Wilson, Chief Thompson, Jack Plunk, Suzy Michelson

Meeting called to order at 6:00pm

2. Minutes from last meeting reviewed. Corrections to the names of members George and Lynn Hoffman-Wirtz. Motion to adopt minutes by Chief. Seconded by Lynn. Passed.

3. Officers--address this at the next meeting.

4. We may have sold one more. We've sold around half of them, about 35. We only paid for 40. The most popular is the bright neon yellow.
Motion made to buy a few more in the neon only. They cost \$8 each, we have \$420 in the bank. Moved to buy 30 more. Seconded. Motion passed.

Shirts are still not on display. Jack has talked to Mrs. Burns about it. The Depot resists displaying them there due to thefts of items from vestibule. We need to continue to press them for displays to encourage sales. Displaying them at the Rec Center should be easy enough, if they lock the display models up at night. We will try using coat hangers for now.

Most of the shirts are currently sold at city hall, where they are on display.

5. Jack talked with Ms. Burns about the display case near the trail that is on the wrong side. We hope action will be taken.

The city is going on its own to do the creekside trail.

There is a letter attached to the agenda about the sharrows. We are waiting for warmer weather, so that the paint can cure before they release the road to traffic.

6. We have done things towards each of the 5 E's (sharrows, share the road signs, etc.). We are moving in the right direction, but have a ways to go. Jack is encouraging all of us to join the League of American Bicyclists.

In the city's update to their comprehensive plan, they've included all of our projects.

Hampton Inn and University Inn have accepted our maps and brochures and will be passing them out.

7. campground-- Ron talked to Denise about one. Mayor has mentioned one before. We might need to press getting one up at the back of the community recreation center. They could sell spots.

benches-- Ron was suggesting that the next time we put benches up on the trail that we offer advertising on them to local businesses for a price.

Ron was suggesting we get a nice sign like the Eubanks Center sign for our Depot.

A Greenleaf trail is being seriously considered. When the road construction is finished, we should get a cut to the trail from here, which would help the Hampton and the neighborhoods over there.

Coldwater Creek trail is being planned without a bridge.
