Coosa Basin ACWP Steering Committee Meeting Minutes 2/8/18

Lem Burell – Reviewed **minutes** from last meeting in August 2017. Meeting in November was not held due to semi-annual Coosa Basin Conference.

Comments on minutes–

- No change on getting a forester for DeKalb Co.
- Pet waste station – need to find out who to purchase bags for re-stocking. Jeremy said that Gadsden purchased bags to re-stock.

Financial -

- Several sponsors for the Coosa Basin Conference. Logan Martin Lake Protection Association paid expenses and was reimbursed through ACWP from sponsorships.
- Balance: \$5,994.73

2017 Conference Review -

- 3rd semi-annual conference; approximately 75 attendees
- Conference went well with positive response

Winter Wonderland Presentation by Lem -

- Highlighted several beautiful, frozen and snowy waterfall and lake photos that he took in the Coosa Basin and other areas, including Desoto State Park waterfalls, Sugar Falls (Calhoun CO.), Morgan Lake (Cleburne Co.), High Falls (Talladega Co.), High Falls Scenic Area (Clay Co.).

Subbasin Stakeholder Committee Reports -

Upper

- Vicki Goggans (DeKalb Co. SWCD)
 - The DeKalb Co. Water Festival (W.O.W.) went well; 800 students attended
 - The Neely Henry Watershed Project (Section 319 project targeting Big Wills subwatersheds in DeKalb County) is ongoing. Landowners are continuing to install BMPS to target agricultural sources of nutrients. Will request an extension on this project until the end of the year.

Middle

- Jeramy Ward (City of Gadsden)
 - The Etowah Co. Water Festival will be held February 16th (first attempt was cancelled due to snow).
 - Starting a suspension bridge at the bottom of gorge at Noccaculla Falls
 - Developing a waterfront concert venue and development in Gadsden
 - Weiss Lake Renew Our Rivers Cleanup (ROR) – April 28
- Charity Mitcham (St. Clair Co. SWCD)
 - Logan Martin ROR – March 17-24

- SWCD will be presenting “Classroom in the Forest” at two schools to approximately 245 students.
- Choccolocco Watershed Group
 - Lem met with them and spoke at their conference in November 2017, on ACWP and Coosa CWP. He met a teacher from Munford High School who invited the Coosa Basin CWP to hold a meeting at their school. Requested that the kiosk be placed at Munford next.
- Frank Chitwood (Coosa Riverkeepers)
 - Reported that APCO has finished installing an aerator at Logan Martin, to increase dissolved oxygen vital to mussel and snail habitat.
 - Gadsden is working with USFWS to remove a low head dam on Big Wills Creek that is dangerous to kayakers.

Lower

- Dan Murchison (Lake Mitchell)
 - Game & Fish talked to HOBOS about crappie population and concerns at Lake Mitchell. Said less crappie; less than 10% survival rate after restocking; looking at causes of mortality issues.
 - ROR Cleanup – March 24
- Chilton Co. Water Festival – March 16
- Lay Lake ROR – April 7
- Lake Jordan ROR – April 14

Agency/Partner Reports

- ADEM Update (Missy Middlebrooks)
 - Section 319 grant applications will be due July 1, to support watershed project implementation.
 - New 2018 303(d) draft list will be available on the ADEM website February 11th; approximately 89 new pathogen listings
 - 2018 Nonpoint Source Conference will be held March 15 in Montgomery. Registration is now open.
- Forestry (Ryan Peek)
 - BMP monitoring ongoing
 - Many complaints after all the rain. 10 complaints with 7 valid. AFC is in the process of addressing.
 - Working with a wetland/404 permit issue for a landowner that built a road that is acting as a dam on AL River in Clark Co., with no permits, no culverts.
 - Decreased AFC staff, from 6 to 4 regions. 26 counties have no designated foresters.
 - Bruce Springer was appointed Asst. State Forester.
 - Black Warrior Waterdog salamander was listed as endangered; affects Coosa Basin
- Coosa Riverkeepers (Frank Chitwood)
 - Just hired a program manager – Carly – in charge of SWIM Guide

- Frank showed the new Fish Guide app on their website that was launched this week.
 - Sent monitors thermometers and once a week they test water temp; goes into database and embedded into clickable sites on a map for fisherman.
 - Tells temp, lake level, flow (USGS), boat ramp locations, restaurants, fish consumption advisory link, marinas, parks, game fish guide
 - How-to video on how to clean/cook fish to reduce PCB exposure
 - Developing rack cards to advertise the app to place at fishing stores
- Noted that there is a new Facebook page that he found called Save the Coosa Grass that is against the spraying of weeds in lakes. Many fishermen have joined because they see the “grass” as habitat and good fishing location.
- 2018 Goals & Activities: What can they do for MS4s water, HOBO, SWCD, agencies?

2018 Goals and Activities

- Lem talked to Heidi Richards (former Coosa Basin CWP facilitator and now the new Director of the RC&D) and asked about the possibility of hiring Heidi with the remaining Coosa Basin funding. Said she can do this, but would have to ask her RC&D Board.
- Dan Murchison said we need to decide the goals of the CWP and who we are going to target. HOBOs need information on how to control growth on lakes and solar energy promotion. Also need information to put in a packet to give to new homeowners and articles to publish in newsletters on environmental issues: litter, septic tank maintenance, etc. Requested that there be a contact for each agency to be the person to bring the information to the HOBO groups.
- Charity Mitcham said she did not understand why we should pay someone else to do what we (the subcommittee members) are already doing. Suggested using the funding to purchase things like pet waste stations and rain barrels for workshops.
- New AL Stormwater Association – Scott Rogers (ALDOT) is heading up. Next meeting in Moody.
- Frank suggested that we could also help with local water festival supplies, if needed.
- Need additional representatives to serve on the Executive Committee to decide approval of funding. Currently:
 - Lower – Russell Harry
 - Upper - ?
 - Middle - ?
 - ?

Lem ask committee to share ideas with him if think of people to fill slots.

- Decided to hold onto funds as opposed to putting into facilitator, to use for materials for workshops and educational activities.
