

Preschoolers' Storytime

Thursdays at 10:00 a.m.

Designed for children from **3 to 6 years of age**, Preschoolers' Storytime is an early literacy program that uses interactive stories, songs, and activities to help your preschooler get ready to read. Your child will build language, math, listening and social skills, while having fun! Craft included. (Coloring sheets for 2 y/o & younger.)

Feb. 6 – “Around the World” – We will explore continents and countries in faraway places!

Feb. 13 – “Valentine’s Day” – Discover ways to share your love with the people who are special in your life. Children may swap valentines if they please.

Feb. 20 – “Good Friends” – There’s nothing quite as much fun as playing with our friends! Find out what makes a good friend and how to make new friends.

Feb. 27 – “The Joke’s on You!” – Learn how to tell a good joke. (Joke telling increases confidence & stimulates thinking in young children)

Especially for your baby, Tiny Tots Storytime is an interactive early literacy program designed for children **0 to 2 years of age**. Your child will be amused and stimulated by age-appropriate stories, activities, and songs, which will enhance the developmental skills your toddler is so busy mastering!

Tiny Tots Storytime will be held at the same time as Preschoolers' Storytime (but in different rooms) for the convenience of parents who have children in both age groups. Of course, older children are always welcome.
