

**City Council**  
**Regular Work Session Minutes**  
**Jacksonville, Alabama**  
**April 27, 2020**

The Council of the City of Jacksonville, Alabama, met on April 27, 2020, at 6:30 p.m. virtually via Zoom Meeting for a Regular Work Session. Council President Sandra Sudduth called the meeting to order at 6:34 p.m. The following Council Members were present: Jerry Parris, Terry Wilson, Tony Taylor, and Coty Galloway. Mayor Johnny L. Smith, City Administrator Albertha Grant, City Attorney Richard Rhea and City Clerk Brenda Sandoval were present.

**TELECOMMUNICATION MEETING:** Council President Sudduth explained that the City was on Level III of our Infectious Disease/Pandemic Policy, allowing us to have our meeting via telecommunications.

**MINUTES.** No changes to the minutes.

**JPWP #20-102, REMOVAL OF MASONRY VENEER OF WEST WALL AT THE JACKSONVILLE COMMUNITY CENTER.** Mayor explained to the Council that we are ready to move forward with the project at the Community Center. The price is \$48,471.00, this price is only to open it up by removing the masonry veneer. Once the weather cooperates and it dries out, it should only take about a week to complete. This is on the Agenda tonight for voting.

**PUBLIC SAFETY COMPLEX POND.** Update on Public Safety Pond, we are waiting for the weather to dry up so that the pond will drain on its own so that they can perform the tests on the pond that need to be performed to determine if anything needs to be addressed.

**OTHER BUSINESS.**

- Council Member Galloway asked for an update on the purchase of the Firetruck. Mayor stated that they do have quotes from 5 or 6 banks, but they were waiting for one more. Laura Copeland has put it all in a spreadsheet for everyone to review and hopefully that will get out to the Council in the next few days.
- Council Member Taylor asked what they Mayors thoughts were on opening back up. The Mayor explained that he plans to back up on the Levels of the Infectious Disease/Pandemic Policy. At this time, he is waiting on Governor Ivey to determine how we will proceed. His thoughts were that we would possibly have a called Work Session to discuss after the Governors press conference.
- Water treatment plant received a great report.
- The Mayor explained to the Council that there is an addition to the Agenda adding a Police Officer. Wanted the Council to be aware that this person will be starting at Range 15 due to his experience.
